- Carrie: "It's a buyer's market. There are a lot of jobs out there and not very many qualified candidates."
- Aaron suggests that the teachers and parents be included in the second round as well; Carrie outlined a method by which that might be accommodated;
- A lot of discussion around lack of trust within the parent community
- Eve: How do we recruit candidates? Many outside sources like Monster, etc. and What specifically do they know? A general listing as well as specific school names and Are all round 1 parent and teacher members included in round 2? No, but it can be tailored to MHF
- the process is expected to be complete by early to mid April
