What am I Making for Breakfast?!

Craving a tasty treat for breakfast? Try these easy and yummy muffins . . .

Honey Muffins

- 2 cups all-purpose flour
- ½ cup sugar
- 3 teaspoons baking powder
- ½ teaspoon salt
- 1 large egg, room temperature
- 1 cup milk
- ¼ cup butter, melted
- ¼ cup honey

Preheat oven to 400 degrees.

In a large bowl, combine flour, sugar, baking powder and salt. In a small bowl, combine egg, milk, butter and honey. Stir into dry ingredients just until moistened.

Fill paper-lined muffin cups three-fourths full. Bake until a toothpick inserted in center comes out clean - about 15-18 minutes. Cool 5 minutes before removing from pan to a wire rack.

Serve warm and ENJOY!
